- TI-84+ or TI-84+ Silver calculator with cables and manual
- 100 index cards
- Notebook paper
- Pens, pencils, red pens, graph paper, etc

All 11th and 12th grade students should have

- Thumb drive (+2GB)
- TI-84+ or TI-84+ Silver calculator with cables and manual
- 200 index cards
- Notebook paper
- Pens, pencils, red pens, graph paper, etc.
- Active GaFutures.org account
